

Mr. Michael Puckett:

During the visit to our facility it was found that we were in violation of Chapter 22, Article 15, Section 1 et. Seq. of the Code of West Virginia and/or Section(s) 33CSR-1-4.8.a.4 of the Rules and Regulations. We failed to take all necessary measures to collect and treat leachate that was released when our liner was uncovered for tie-in.

**HAM Sanitary Landfill, LLC.**, has taken corrective action on the matter. We have temporary confined and diverted the leachate to a manhole that feeds our tanks. This is a temporary fix. To enable completion of our construction Lynch will be placing a temporary French drain in that will be piped into the same manhole that feeds the tanks. Once the liner tie-in is complete this problem will be permanently fixed.

## NOTICE OF CIVIL ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY

In accordance with West Virginia Code 22-15-15(c) you are hereby notified that H.A.M. Sanitary Landfill, LLC has been assessed a proposed civil administrative penalty on the Notice of Violation dated May 24, 2017.

The proposed penalty of \$2,340 was calculated using the attached CAP Calculation Form in accordance with Legislative Rule, Title 33, Series 22.

Pursuant to West Virginia Code 22-15-15(c), you may contest the fact of the violation or the amount of the proposed penalty by requesting an informal hearing by completing and returning the enclosed card within **twenty (20) days** upon receipt of the Notice of Civil Administrative Penalty.

Pursuant to Legislative Rule 33CSR22-5.3.d, there is provision to reduce the Civil Administrative Penalty for ability to pay a civil administrative penalty. Should you desire to pursue this provision, you should be prepared to present all necessary supportive information and/or financial documentation at the scheduled informal hearing. <u>Incomplete information or information received more than ten (10) calendar days after the informal hearing date will not be evaluated.</u>

The purpose of this letter is to identify the parameters, which have exceeded our discharge limitations, to identify the probable causes, and to identify actions that will be implemented in an effort to correct the conditions causing the elevated levels.

The benchmark concentration for Ammonia- Nitrogen was exceeded on the IUO2 sample collected from a 24 hour Comp. The measured Ammonia- Nitrogen level was 206 mg/L. The benchmark concentration level is 40 mg/L for Ammonia-Nitrogen. The other parameters were in reasonable concentration levels.

Upon conducting of an investigation into the cause of the elevated level, we have concluded that the elevated level is being caused by:

- (1) The decomposition of the hay that is being used for erosion control on new construction
- (2) The increase in MSW tonnage that is being brought in from new business.

In the future we plan to use a Leachate Pond, which is completed and awaiting approval to be put into service, to aid in the aeriation of such parameters. We also expect this Ammonia-Nitrogen level to begin to decrease on its own, once composition grass begins to take root and the hay is degraded.
