ORDER FOR CONTINUANCE AND NOTICE OF HEARING


Appeal No. 21-06-EQB was filed with the West Virginia Environmental Quality Board (“Board”) on June 23, 2021. An evidentiary hearing for the above-styled appeal was scheduled for November 9-10, 2022. The parties submitted a Joint Motion to Continue and represented they have reached an agreement-in-principle on all issues currently under appeal and said agreement is being effectuated through a permit modification application. The parties requested a sixty (60) day continuance in order to all time for the permit modification process to be completed.

Accordingly, the Board does hereby ORDER that the evidentiary hearing in Appeal No. 21-06-EQB shall be continued until the **January 12-13, 2023**, Board meeting. Said hearing will begin at **8:30 a.m.** at the Board’s offices located at 601 57th Street, Charleston, Kanawha County, West Virginia 25304.
