JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE AND MOTION TO EXTEND STAY

COMES NOW Cleveland-Cliffs Weirton LLC (“Appellant” or “CC Weirton”), by counsel, Marc C. Bryson, Marissa G. Nortz, and the law firm of Steptoe & Johnson PLLC, and Appellee, Katheryn D. Emery, Acting Director of the Division of Water and Waste Management, West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (hereinafter “Appellee” or “WVDEP”), by counsel, and respectfully moves the West Virginia Environmental Quality Board (hereinafter “Board”) for a **sixty (60) day** continuance of the above-styled appeal. In support of this Motion, the parties state as follows:

1. This matter is currently scheduled for an evidentiary hearing before this Board on May 11-12, 2022.
2. The parties have met to discuss settlement and settlement discussions between the parties are ongoing. With regard to certain appealed parameters, the parties have scheduled meetings with USEPA in late April.
3. To this end, the parties are hopeful that they can settle this matter without an evidentiary hearing and need additional time to work towards settlement.

4. Resolution and settlement of this appeal is in the best interests of the parties and is in concert with established judicial principles which favor (1) a negotiated resolution to disputes, and (2) the efficient use of limited judicial resources.
5. Per the Board's September 19th, 2022, Order granting the Appellant's request for a limited stay, the Appellant hereby requests that the Board's Stay be extended to correspond with the date of the continued hearing should the Board grant this Joint Motion to Continue. WVDEP does not object to this request.

Therefore, for the reasons set forth more thoroughly above, the Parties jointly move this Board to continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter for a period of **sixty (60) days**. Appellant moves this Board to extend the Stay granted in this matter to correspond to the new hearing date.
